Due to school closure before half term, we were unable to run our maths activity morning. We have rescheduled this for

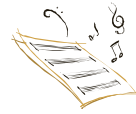
Wednesday 4th March which is also World Maths Day. Children will be taking part in a number of problem solving / maths activities throughout the morning.
